Class Descriptions

Chemistry: (Apologia Chemistry required.) Student will cover a module every two weeks. Lab experiments will be done in class. Instructor: Susan Potter, Cost: \$85 per semester plus \$10 lab fee

Physical Science: 8th – 10th grade, BJU 3rd Edition Physical Science text, Introduction to Chemistry and Physics. Lots of hands on learning. Instructor: Penny Martin, Cost: \$85 per semester

Grammar & Composition (7-12th grades) Foundational course in grammar, diagramming & composition. Text: The Scarlet Pimpernel by Orczy, MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers. Instructor: Katie Schmidt Cost: \$85 per semester.

Excellence in Writing Level C Continuation Course Year 2: For the high school student who has completed SICC-C lessons 1 - 16. This second year focuses on persuasive, super and personal essays along with news summaries and Letters to the Editor. Cost: \$85 per semester. Instructor: Susan Potter (meets every other week)

Geography (8th – 12th grade) – Explore a continent at a time – maps, culture, religion, traditions. Text: Cultural Geography 9 BJU Press. Instructor: Katie Schmidt Cost: \$85 per semester.

Accounting (8th – 12th grade) – Introductory accounting and basic bookkeeping. Exposing students to the basics of business. Instructor: Miriam Woods Cost: \$85 fall semester only.

Apologetics/World Religions (9-12th grade) – Help students understand their faith – Christianity, know their "opponents" ideas and learn to win others to Christ. Text: New Evidence that Demands a Verdict by Josh McDowell. Instructor: Katie Schmidt Cost: \$85 per semester.

Western Civilization II (9-12th grade) – World History 11: Late Middle Ages to present day Text: *Western Civilization: A History of European Society*, 2nd edition by Hause & Maltby. Instructor: Katie Schmidt, Cost: \$85 Semester plus \$8 copy fee
