10 Weeks of Thursday Enrichment Classes for Your Homeschool Students!

Enrichment Day Goals:

1. To glorify God as we represent both Christ and homeschooling in a positive light to the community.
2. To exhibit and grow in Christ-like behavior in our attitudes, actions and words as we interact with others.
3. To experience fun and fellowship as friendships are developed with like-minded peers while we learn and work together.
4. To provide supplemental learning opportunities to enrich our children's education in the areas of physical education, the arts, life skills, and other electives.

Enrichment Day Expectations:

"Enrichment Day" is a cooperative effort on the part of C.A.C.H.E. homeschooling families who desire to work with other homeschooling families in the Body of Christ to enrich our children's education. Classes are coordinated, supervised and led by homeschool parents. Programs operate on a co-op basis, so every adult is expected to be an active participant on one team (see options below) - sharing input, ideas, planning and presenting material, and assisting however needed. When children are present, a parent from that family must also be present in the building (unless prior arrangements have been made with the Support Team).

AM Classes will meet Thursday mornings at 9:30—12:00 pm, Feb. 2 - April 5 at First Baptist Church, 1110 S. Cochran, Charlotte, MI 48813.

(There is also an optional picnic lunch fellowship time from noon to 12:30p.m.)

Classes for birth—age 5

Nursery/Preschool: Your child will be cared for in a warm and loving atmosphere. Preschoolers will be engaged in a routine of art, snack, story time and songs.

Classes for Age 6—13:

Students rotate through two classes

Life Skills: Students will learn a variety of life skills based on the abilities of the families involved. Possible offerings: CPR/first aid, knitting and crocheting, basic sewing, making homemade bread, soap/candle making, gardening/food preservation, basic car maintenance, scrapbooking, calligraphy, etc basic fundamentals of science each week with fun hands on science experiments.

Gym: Students will be provided with basic instruction in athletics and participate in a variety of wholesome recreational games and activities.
